#### Accelerating Electrification in New Buildings

- Prohibition on Natural Gas in New Buildings in the Health and Safety Code
- Proposing: Electric-favored Reach Code & EV Readiness in the Building Code
- California Environmental Quality Act Mitigation Measure



The California city on Tuesday voted to ban natural gas hook-ups



### Berkeley Electrification for New Construction

Prohibition on Natural Gas	Reach Code (Proposed)
Covers projects with Land Use Permit application submitted after January 1, 2020	Covers projects with Building Permit application submitted after January 2020 pending California Energy Commission (CEC) approval
Applies to Newly Constructed Buildings	Applies to Newly Constructed Buildings
Prohibits natural gas infrastructure in buildings	Provides two compliance pathways: All-electric or more efficient mixed-fuel
Provides feasibility and public interest exemptions	Efficiency requirements for mixed-fuel based on cost-effectiveness and CEC approval

#### Why a Reach Code when we have a Prohibition?

- Triggers differ (building vs land use permit application)
- Regional alignment
- Influence 2022 Energy Code
- Specifies requirements in code
- Legally sound approach





#### Accelerating Electrification in Existing Buildings

- Pathways to Clean Energy Buildings Strategic Plan for inclusive electrification

# Existing Buildings – Building Energy Saving Ordinance (BESO)

- Annual benchmarking & 5 year audit for large buildings
- Home Energy Score at Time of Sale
- Shifting from Energy Efficiency to include Electrification
