To be eligible, students must be:

- Currently enrolled undergraduates at an accredited institution in North America
- Pursuing a course of study related to building efficiency (architecture, engineering, etc.)
- Able to commit to 4 hours per month for the full 5-month program that will run from June to November with a break in August

What the program provides:

- One-on-one mentorship
- Discussion groups on crucial industry topics with experts
- The opportunity to attend the 2021 Getting to Zero Forum (October 27-29), the premier conference dedicated to zero energy and carbon neutral buildings
- Resume building activities like writing a blog for the Getting to Zero Forum website, presenting a poster at the Getting to Zero Forum, and more
